You will not be charged for transactions made from your Everyday Transaction Account using Desjardins ATMs, AccèsD Internet, mobile services, AccèsD Telephone and at a caisse. However, certain fees may apply in other cases.²

Other advantages and discounts available

As a member of the Desjardins Merit Service, you're entitled to free personalized cheques (Merit model, 100 cheques/year) and free drafts issued in Canadian or US dollars. You are also entitled to a yearly discount of \$5 on the fees charged for the rental of a safety deposit box.

They must inform you of the fee via an on-screen message before processing the transaction. You then have the option of cancelling the transaction. These fees are added to the withdrawal amount and paid directly to the ATM operator.
